

Riedell Speed Insole Size Chart

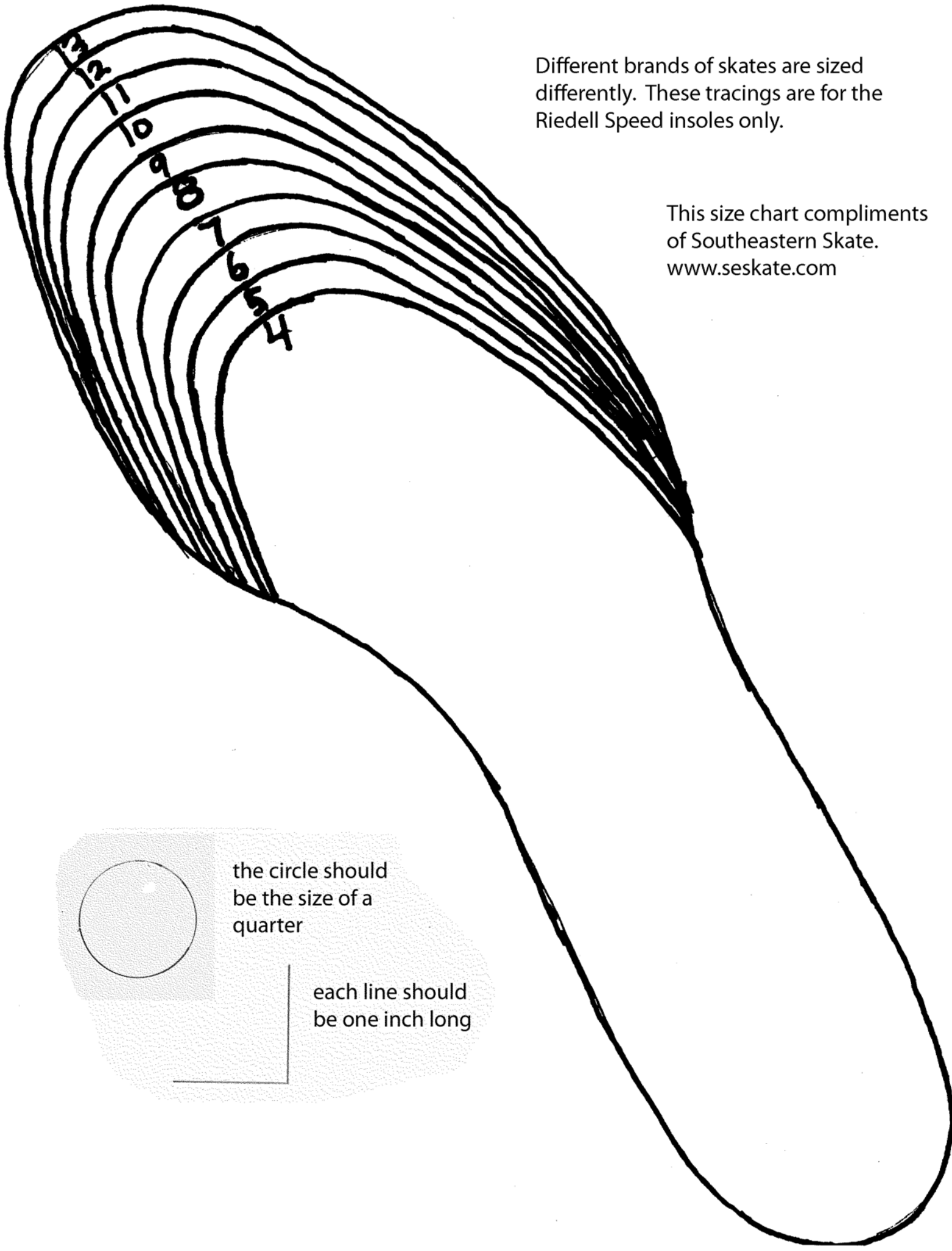
The best way to size up a skate is to actually take the time to try it on. An insole size chart is not going to be as accurate, but it can be a helpful starting point.

All skates are not sized the same, this chart is for RIEDELL SPEED SHOES only.

It is very important to make sure that you have a good printing of this size chart. As you start to print this, look for an option called “print scaling” and make sure that you select “none” before you click on the “okay to print” box. Once the chart has printed, check the accuracy by looking on the bottom left corner for the tracing of a quarter and the measurement of one inch and making sure that they are indeed the right size.
